- 2023 Collaborative video/poem “chapbook” titled COMPASS – which was awarded an Individual Artist Grant in Poetry funded by NYSCA and made in collaboration with filmmaker Laura Frare – won “Best Experimental Short” in the NYSWI Albany Film Festival.
- 2023 Chosen to be included in the “Tabletop Poem” project by Dr. Joseph Bruchac, Saratoga Poet Laureate, Carol Graser and Caffe Lena, in which an installation of individual poems appeared for the month of September 2023 on the tables of Caffe Lena in celebration of the Caffe Lena’s Poetry Open Mic’s 20th Anniversary and its host, poet Carol Graser. My poem “Heartsease,” first published in Poetry Ireland Review, was featured.
- 2021 Screening of video/poem video/poem “chapbook” titled COMPASS, which was awarded an Individual Artist Grant in Poetry funded by NYSCA and made in collaboration with filmmaker Laura Frare. Screening took place at Saratoga Arts Center and Saratoga Arts made this project possible with a 2020 Individual Artist Grant funded by the New York State Council on the Arts with the support of the Governor and the New York State Legislature.
- 2021 Video/poems “Five Easy Pieces,” and “Nightjar” (both originally published at *Tupelo Press*, 2021), both collaborations with filmmaker Laura Frare, chosen for screening at the *Annual Peoples Pixel Project*, a Festival of Short Films sponsored by the Lake George Arts Project. “Nightjar” was an Award Winner.
- 2020 Awarded an Individual Artist Grant in Poetry funded by NYSCA to make a video/poem “chapbook” for screening - a collaboration with filmmaker Laura Frare. Saratoga Arts made this project possible with a 2020 Individual Artist Grant funded by the New York State Council on the Arts with the support of the Governor and the New York State Legislature.
- 2019 Video/poem “Mare Nubium,” Sea of Clouds (collaboration with filmmaker Laura Frare) screened at the 2019 Artists of the Mohawk Hudson Region Art Exhibition, Hyde Collection; Juror, Victoria Palermo
- 2019 Poem “On Returning A Diebenkorn to the University Art Museum” awarded Honorable Mention Prize in the Hudson Valley Writers Guild Poetry Contest
